


Working together with the Nottingham City Learning Disability and Autism Partnership Board (Splat)

4 Board meetings




These meetings involve a large number of people with a learning disability and people with autism.



Although we work with lots of people with learning disabilities we have found it difficult to get carers involved.



Our contract with Nottingham City Council and the Clinical commissioning group ends on 31st March 2018.



Part of our contract is to set Splat up as an independent organisation that can get its own funding and continue their work.



Working together



This change has given us the chance to think about how we do things and what could be done differently, including how we could work with the County Board.



A few people from the City and the County board's had a chat about this.



We thought it would useful to come up with some ideas about how we might work together to help each board think about what we could do

We could;



• Share what we do well



• Learn from each other



Give a voice to more people who use services and carers



• Talk about things that affect everyone, whether they live in the City or the County.



Ideas about how we could do this



We think this would take time to organise and would not be something that happens too quickly

To start with we could try:



 Service users and carer representatives from the County Board coming to Splat meetings and Splat reps going to the County Board meetings



 County service user representative on the Splat Steering Board



 3 Board meetings a year where Splat and the County Board look at their own issues



• 3 shared meetings to look at things that affect everyone



 Splat working towards having 2 extra Board meetings so they have 6 meetings like the County Board
