April 2015 Board meeting

How Splat works

- Have reps from advocacy, transport, leisure and the police. Invite other people, depending on what the meeting is about
- We need a Chair who has power and can make things happen (for example, a councilor)
- The Chair should work with a person with a learning disability and a person with autism.

Strategic Commissioning Review

- The Council will write a report
- Decision makers will meet in May to decide what they will work on for the next few months. Clare will tell the next Board meeting what is happening
- Clare will find out what is happening with the list of activities called 'Looking after each other'.

July 2015 Board meeting

Work and Health

- Liz will show presentation at the Health Partnerships Group
- Jim will join the Work Group
- Clare will get information from the different groups so the Work Group knows everything that is happening
- Clare will tell the next SPLAT Board what the groups are doing and when the work will be done.

Advocacy

- Clare will meet James to discuss issues from SPLAT Board.
- Clare will give VOX information about the current contract
- VOX will arrange a special meeting to look at the gaps in advocacy and other ways people could get this support
- James will come to SPLAT Board meetings.

Safe Places

- SPLAT Board members will tell people about Safe Places
- Members will tell Denise about places in the community they think should be part of the scheme.

Autism Co-production group

SPLAT members will look at the e-learning package and give comments to Ken by the end of August.

The use of medicines in people with learning disabilities

- Trevor will give an update at the next SPLAT Board

November 2015 Board meeting

Work and Health

- The Council should map the different health and work groups so the **Work Group** knows what is happening?
- Find out if any local groups applied for Skills Funding Agency European grants to help people get better skills
- What happened about Jim joining the **Work Group**?

Fast Track

- Georgina will ask someone from NHS England to come to SPLAT Board meetings
- Denise will ask the police about a rep on the Splat Board
- We will have an update on Fast track at every Board

Advocacy

- Rasool will send details of the new advocacy contract
- Rasool will look at how we can link with the East Midlands Advocacy Programme.

Information to help people make choices

- Find out if the City CCG have a community support worker like Notts. CCG West
- Board members will check if their information answers the 3 key questions from the Working Group

- What can I expect?
- Who do I contact?
- What happens if things change or I need more information?

They will feedback at next Board meeting

- Splat to these questions to develop a toolkit for services to check their information. Use this to put pressure on leisure, travel and other services to think about the information people need
- Nick will bring Pohwer's information sheets to the next Listening Day to see what people think
