Jake Jacobs sent an update to the meeting.


Jake hoped someone else would carry on looking at jobs for people with learning disabilities. But the council needs to work on some other urgent things first.

Theodore and Sara could not come to this meeting so Sharon gave an update




People should not live in hospital for a long time. But it is hard to find providers who can give people the support they need. Commissioners will look at the information and try again.

Going out at night


Karen is helping people with learning disabilities go out safely at night. She will train pubs and clubs to support people with learning disabilities and tell the police if things don't look right.

Working with the Police and courts


Karen wants to make sure people with learning disabilities are treated in the right way.
