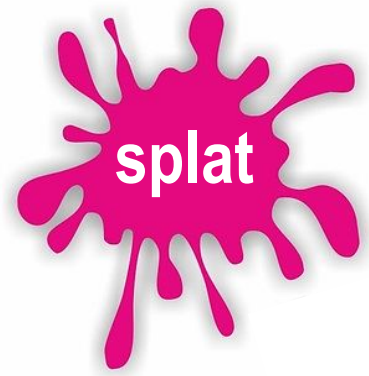


# Meeting Notes –6<sup>th</sup> September 2017

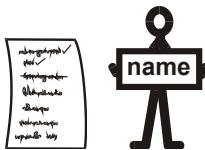

The list of people who came to the meeting and people who said they could not come.



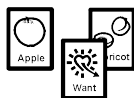
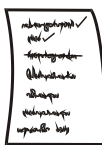
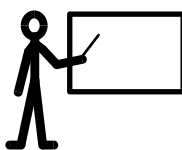
## Actions from last time

Sharon will ask Mike what happens about Splat information now.

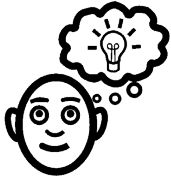

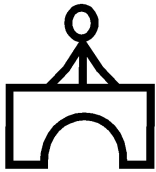


### Work - work

The council will work with Oak Field School to find work placements for students with the council.



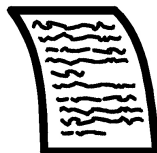
### Things we agreed about Work

### Advocacy - update

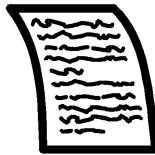

### Things we agreed about Advocacy

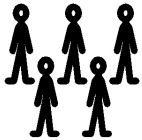


Annie will contact Nick to see if his job has changed. She will ask if there is an update to send with these notes.

People should not live in hospital for a long time. But it is hard to find providers who can give people the support they need. Commissioners will look at the information and try again.



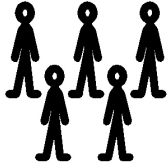
A special team will work with support providers to help people stay in their homes in the community.

Ask Tess Hullett to come to the next Board to talk about supporting children and young people.



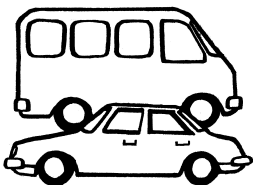
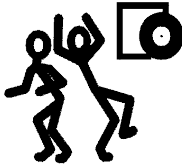
## Autism Strategy Group – update

### Working with the Police and courts

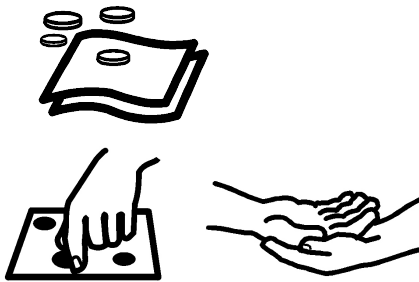
Karen wants to make sure people with learning disabilities are treated in the right way.

Karen is working with Transport and Travel Trainers to make things safer for people with disabilities to travel at night.

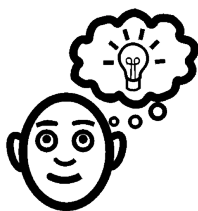


## Integrated Personal Commissioning (IPC)

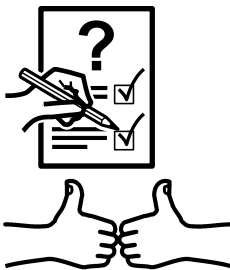


IPC helps people choose how they get support. It brings together **personal health budgets** and **personal budgets**.

This means you know how much your services cost but can choose how to spend the money on the support you need.



The working group asked if some people could use IPC to be involved with Splat. They said it helps with their health and social care needs in lots of different ways.

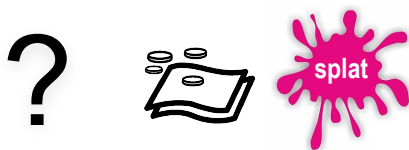


The group said we need a checklist to make sure people still get all these things from working with Splat in the future.

Trevor talked about NHS England sessions on IPC. He will give them the information from the Working Group and ask how they link with Tinu.



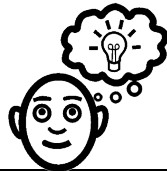
Annie will email Tinu to ask if some people could use IPC for support with Splat.



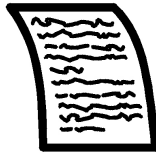
The Steering Group will look at how to use the checklist idea.

Sharon is involved with the steering group. She said their contract with the City Council says Vox will support Splat to be independent by the end of March 2018. She thinks a CIC is a good way to do this.



The council might be able to help with some money to set up the CIC.



Some steering group members met Konrad from the County Board to talk about working together. We wrote a paper about this and asked the City Board if they agreed with the ideas.



We talked about the things that need to happen to set up the CIC. We asked if everyone was happy for the steering group to get on with these.

Everyone voted to work with County Board on some things that affect people in both the city and county



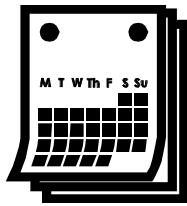
Everyone voted for the steering group to work on setting up the CIC and report back to the December board meeting.
