**Audio Described Performance** for blind or partially sighted customers via personalised headphones.


Braille and Large Print cast lists. Programme notes broadcast 15 minutes before the performance


Touch tours for visually impaired customers to go onto the stage and explore the sets, costumes and props before the performance begins
